

Quick Reference Guide (with Images): TalkBack 8.2 for Android

Recommended browser: Chrome (Android OS 7.0 or higher), Firefox (Older versions of Android OS)

Getting Started

Or explore by touch

Enabling TalkBack: Go to Settings > Accessibility > TalkBack to turn on TalkBack. To activate the TalkBack shortcut, go to Settings > Accessibility and turn on the Volume Key Shortcut. You can then hold the volume keys for three seconds to turn TalkBack on or off.

The Local Context Menu: contains navigation options relevant to the current page. Options appear in a menu list by default. To open the local context menu, swipe up, then right.

The Global Context Menu: contains options relevant anywhere on your device. Options appear in a menu list by default. To open the global context menu, swipe down, then right.

Reading controls: allow adjustment of reading settings, such as being able to swipe to read by headings or by lines. Swipe down or up to cycle through the different reading controls.



Reading Text

Say prior line, word, character



1. Select the desired reading control 2. Swipe left



1. Open Global Context Menu 2. Select "Read from next item"



1. Open Global Context Menu 2. Select "TalkBack Settings" > "Verbosity" > "Speak phonetic letters"




1. Select the desired reading control 2. Swipe right



1. Navigate by words 2. Open Global Context Menu 3. Select "Spell last utterance"

Tables









Note: TalkBack reads table cells in order left to right, starting at the top row.

Forms

Select and deselect checkboxes



Double tap

Open combo box (<select>)



Double tap

Browse combo box options



Explore by touch Or swipe right or left

Select multiple combo box options



Double tap each option to select or deselect

Toggle radio button selection




1. Swipe right or left to the desired option

2. Double tap to select

Other Commands



Swipe right, then left



Swipe left, then right

Typing: When in a text editing field, a virtual keyboard appears at bottom of screen. Drag finger over letters, and release when you hear the desired letter.

Speak characters typed: Go to "TalkBack Settings" > "Verbosity" > "Keyboard echo" to enable.

Ignore TalkBack, report gesture to current application: Use 2 or 3 fingers.

Gesture hints: Select "TalkBack Settings" > "Verbosity" > "Speak usage hints" to enable.

Note: TalkBack varies depending on the version of Android and the web browser in use. Some options may be unavailable.

Reformat documents for simpler viewing:

Chrome: Go to Chrome settings > Accessibility > select "Simplified view for web pages." A button for simplified view will appear at the bottom of the screen, when supported.

Firefox: Reader View. When viewing an article, the button appears in the URL bar.
